- Build excellent operational and strategic links with each 10GM member and associate partner to identify opportunities, share information/resources and maximise efficiency.
- Maintain and develop relationships with a wide range of stakeholders across public, private and the voluntary, community, and social enterprise (VCSE) sector, including 10GM's member's teams, creating strong partnerships.
- Create a positive, solution focussed GM partnership working environment in line with 10GM's values.
- Identify funding opportunities, develop proposals including accurate budgets, and secure funding for existing/new services.
- Understand national, regional and locality policy and produce regular policy content that can be used by 10GM members to enhance their influencing capabilities.
- Be accountable for the delivery and performance of 10GM's services and projects, including ensuring accurate reporting to 10GM and funders.
- Produce and present high quality oral and written reports as necessary.
- Ensure effective line management and direction to staff as required.
